
Attire during Play

The Club requires all members and accompanying visitors to dress in a manner that reflects the club's traditions and culture.

The Board

- Either the top or bottom wear should be white.
- Tennis shoes should be more than half white.
- For the non-white portion, a single color is permitted.
- Socks should be predominantly white.
- No solid fluorescent or loud colors / No bold lettering and design on tennis wear.
- Please contact the Tennis Director if you have questions about any specific tennis wear.



- Those who need to use functional wear for health reasons, please contact the Tennis Director in advance.
- Instructions provided by the Tennis Director and the Club Manager on appropriate wear in the clubhouse and on the courts are final. Failure to adhere to these rules will result in the member or guest being asked to change clothes.

Update of the Dress Code

In order to encourage all members to dress in a manner that reflects the club's traditions and culture, the Board updated the Dress Code at the March Board Meeting, and it will be effective from September 1st, 2018.

We ask all members to comply with this Dress Code. Please inform visitors of our dress code in advance. You will also find it on the TLTC website under "Club Life"

Dress Code

(1) In the Clubhouse

- a) Members and guests should dress in a manner that reflects the club's traditions and culture.
- b) Please remove caps and visors.
- c) Appropriate tennis wear described below is permitted.

(2) Tennis attire during play

This includes all visible clothing, warm-up, tights (including leggings and spats), shoes, socks and cap. Wear made for tennis is preferred

- a) The preferred color is predominantly white.
- b) Another single color may be worn. Caps, minimal stripes and patterns are permitted. No solid fluorescent or loud colors on tennis wear.
- c) No bold lettering or design on tennis wear.
- d) Men's shirts with collars are preferred.
- e) Clay court or all court shoes are required.
- f) Women's tights must be covered by a skirt. Those who need to use functional wear for health reasons, please contact the club managers in advance.
- g) Warm up clothing should conform to these same rules on tennis attire.

The instructions regarding appropriate wear in the clubhouse and on the courts, given by the club managers are final. Failure to adhere to these rules will result in a person being asked to change.

When in doubt, please consult with the club managers for instructions. The club offers for sale tennis wear and shoes considered appropriate for this club. The office can also direct you to stores that sell such wear, including shoes.
